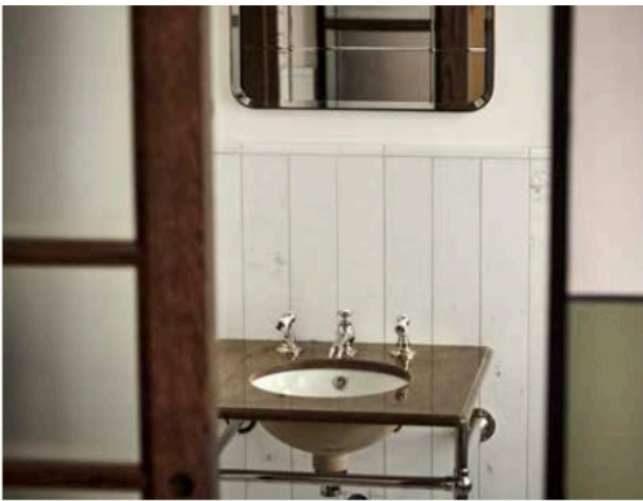

## Stage Night

Alexander Kølpin is at a new stage in his life. After a life spent dancing, the former principal of the Denmark's Royal Ballet is opening a boutique hotel in Copenhagen.

Based near his ex-work – the not-too-shabby Royal Danish Theatre, on Kongens Nytorv – the hotel has been designed with travel and theatre as aesthetic themes.

The London design studio Lind + Almond handled the interiors and architecture,

with polished timber throughout recalling a more opulent age. "The fact that we create a space that you enter as a guest is very similar to the premise of an audience entering the auditorium of the theatre," Kølpin says. "You choose to buy a ticket for a show that plays out in a set, where you have staff/performers performing their part in a defined narrative."
