SANDERS COPENHAGEN Copenhagen, Denmark

The beautiful brainchild of Danish ballet dancer Alexander Kolpin, Sanders encapsulates what Copenhagen does oh so well – pared-back luxury, quiet confidence, and rich yet refined creative and cultural references. Here, guests enter a world that takes its cues from the stage (the Royal Danish Theatre is right in front of the hotel): think sumptuous upholstery within a subdued palette of forest greens, earthy clay and laidback rattan; all perfectly stage-lit by moody lighting. Solo travellers will delight in the train carriage-style Coupe rooms, and long-stay guests will love the Sanders apartment, complete with open fireplace, kitchenette and space to entertain. Sanders Kitchen offers up fresh regional fare that can be enjoyed in the chic tiled dining space, under the stars on the hotel's rooftop Conservatory, or in front of a roaring fire in the leafy central courtyard. Tata, the hotel bar named after the Royal Danish Theatre's beloved red velvet curtains, will no doubt draw local creatives to its sexy surrounds; and stylish staff are on hand to create curated Copenhagen experiences.

PARQ VANCOUVER Vancouver, Canada

Vancouver plays host to a veritable playground of high-end entertainment, dining and accommodation in the form of Parq Vancouver. Two luxury hotels – JW Marriott and the DOUGLAS, an Autograph Collection Hotel – share the prestigious address with eight restaurants and lounges and a 30,000 sq ft rooftop park in what's billed as the largest private development in British Columbia. There's something here for every luxury-lover – whether that's the nature-infused vibe of the DOUGLAS (named after Vancouver's Douglas firs and featuring a 25-foot replica tree in the lobby, a living green wall, Douglas fir-infused gin, and Aesop amenities); the playfulness of JW Marriott (a locally inspired art walk plus extensive Spa by JW amenities); or the range of food and drinks on offer – think Chinese fine dining at 1886, a celebration of local produce at Honey Salt, and top notch drops at Lotus Whiskey and Tea Lounge.



BULGARI RESORT & RESIDENCES DUBAI Dubai, UAE

Italian sophistication meets Middle Eastern exoticism at the hotly anticipated Bulgari Resort & Residences Dubai, with the ultimate 'urban oasis' set to open any minute in Jumeira Bay. Following on from its four predecessors in Milan, Bali, London and Beijing, the resort was designed by renowned Italian architecture firm Antonio Citterio Patricia Viel. The result? A jewel-like triumph of precision and beauty, blending Mediterranean boulevards, lush landscaping, and materials including Italian marble and luxe Italian furnishings with a sense of oceanside escapism. All 101 rooms and 20 villas boast expansive views over the Arabian Gulf or Dubai skyline, complete with large balconies. The BVLGARI Spa takes luxe wellness to the next level, with a 25m indoor pool complete with floor-to-ceiling sea views, soothing vitality pools, aroma steam rooms, ice fountains, private training and a men's barber on offer.
